To receive a First Time Camper Grant from Beth Torah:

All applications must be received by the Beth Torah office by **February 18th, 2022**.

To receive this grant:

- the student must be a child of a member in good standing
- must be attending an approved (see list below) Jewish camp sleep away program of at least three weeks
- must not have attended any Jewish sleep away camp of any length in the past
- must apply for the Community Federation First Time Camper Grant also
- Be enrolled in 4th or 5th grade at the Weiner Religious School or HBHA and have an attendance rate of over 70%.

To receive this grant each family must:

- Apply to the chosen camp, letting the camp know they will be receiving this grant from us
- Send (by email or regular mail) a copy of the application plus a copy of the application for the Federation grant to Tara Hyder at the addresses given below.

The amount of this grant for the camps of 2019 is \$1500.00 or 50% of the total tuition, whichever is less, per camper. Please note that transportation and canteen costs are the responsibility of the family.
